	All attendees gave a brief introduction. It was noted that the Community Network dynamic has changed so the date of the CNP will change to accommodate the new Parish Council meetings. The West Penwith CNP AGM will take place at the next meeting. First Cornwall Council Full Council meeting taking place on 25 May 2021.

3	Review of the last 12 months, key issues & future CNP Meetings – James Hardy		
4	Network Highways Scheme Update- James Hardy		
	 Comments/ discussions: Issues to be raised with Highways from Cllr Elliott: Double Yellows at Newtown Lane and unfinished double yellows in Lower Quarters. Parking enforcement in Lower Quarters (garage and school drop off / pickup). A30 through Crowlas still 40MPH on Cornwall's Interactive Map and on SatNav mapping, so not helping with speeding - James to raise these with the Highways Manager. Cllr McKenna raised concerns on Highway scheme costs. Solar powered Vehicle Activated Signs were included in the Highways schemes (2 sites per parish to install the VAS) and the costs for relocating the sign was included. Request to revisit this with all Parishes to reconfirm the list of requested locations.
